Coercive Control Workshop  
(2.5 hours) (V)

Understand the definition, exploring tactics and behaviours, discuss ever changing stages of coercive control and understanding legislation including evidence gathering

DASH and How to Assess Risk  
(2.5 hours) (V)

Identifying, understanding and assessing risks, including using the Domestic Abuse Stalking and Harassment tool (DASH)  
Essential for those working with families where domestic abuse may be prevalent

Domestic Abuse from a Child’s Perspective  
(2.5 hours) (V)

Considering the impact of domestic abuse on the child and how children are affected when living in homes where there is domestic abuse.

Working with Victims and Perpetrators  
How to work safely with families where the perpetrator is still present  
(to be commissioned)
