

North East Lincolnshire Community Safety Partnership (CSP) Core funding



The Community Safety Partnership (CSP) has a statutory responsibility to deliver the aims of the CSP Partnership Plan within North East Lincolnshire. In order to support this there is funding available to the CSP from the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner (OPCC) to allow the CSP to commission services and develop projects to meet the needs of the population in North East Lincolnshire.

Core Grant funding is available to both external partners (professional agencies) and the CSP task groups and linked partnership strategic groups to apply for to support and develop services that specifically meet the needs of the CSP's priorities and the PCC's Police and Crime Plan. External organisations applying for funding, who are not members of the CSP Board or task groups, should have their application championed by a CSP Board member.

Applications should clearly demonstrate how the proposal will address the priorities of the Community Safety Partnership:

- Overall crime
- Offending and reoffending
- Substance and alcohol misuse
- Anti-social behaviour
- Violent crime
- Domestic abuse
- Child exploitation
- Organised crime groups
- Counter terrorism
- Residents feel safe
- Modern slavery

Reference should also be made to the PCC's Police and Crime Plan aims:

- To deliver increasingly self-sustaining and safe communities in the Humber area
- To build public confidence in the agencies involved in creating safer communities
- To provide services to victims and the most vulnerable that meets their needs

The applicant group will be expected to demonstrate how the need has been identified, gaps in current services and multi-agency or partnership approaches to meet these needs. Match funding and resources 'in kind' should also be clearly explained.

Applications are invited annually before each funding panel meeting in September to allow for a timely decision to be made before the start of the next financial year. For further information please contact rebecca.freeman@nelincs.gov.uk.
